Lottery rules

- The Lottery for members of the Bradford District Credit Union Ltd is a private lottery. It has no connection to any other private or national scheme.
- Juvenile members are NOT permitted to join.
- Lottery numbers will only be issued to any member of the Bradford District Credit Union Ltd who has completed an application form.
- Once an application has been received from a member they will be included in all subsequent Lottery draws, provided there are sufficient funds in their savings account to purchase all their lottery numbers, or until they cancel their lottery application in writing.
- A Lottery Committee elected from the Members at the Annual General Meeting of the Bradford District Credit Union Ltd. will administer the lottery on behalf of the members, and donate the profits to Bradford District Credit Union Ltd.
- The Lottery will be drawn once every month.
- Lottery numbers will be randomly selected and cost £1 each per month. A maximum of 10 lottery numbers may be purchased by any member. Every applicant will be advised of their lottery numbers in writing.
- Prizes will be decided by the Lottery Committee. Prize money will be credited to the winners' savings account with the Credit Union.
- A register of lottery numbers will be kept by the Lottery Committee.
- Winning numbers will be posted on the Credit Union web site www.bdcu.co.uk, and the prize money credited to your account.
